At a recently held league meeting the following important changes were approved:

- The Wellsville Nitros and Rochester Ridgemen were given a one year leave of absence. There will not be teams in these locations in 2019.
- A new franchise was awarded to the Mansfield Destroyers. This team will play in Mansfield, PA, and they will join the Western Division of the NYCBL.
- To reduce team travel expenses, some inter-divisional games will be scheduled as two 7 inning games.
- In 9 inning games, if one team is ahead by 10 runs or more at the end of 7 innings the game will be considered complete.
- The 2019 season will begin on Thursday, June 6th.
