Both players had a great game but the player that faced a key under pressure play, was Nicholas Zielomski. Zielomski was at bat in 6<sup>th</sup> inning with 2 outs and he hit a ball into right field to bring in 2 Rapids runners. During the game Zielomski had 3 hits and 3 RBI's in 4 at bats, that helped put the Rapids over the Oilers. Defensively Stanley, also had another game that impressed fans. Stanley only allowed one hit in his three innings pitched and also had 3 strikeouts. Stanley was the starting pitcher and had set the tempo for the game. Later in the game, Rodriguez had closed the game and picked up the save. Rodriguez pitched 1.2 innings had one strikeout and only allowed one hit.

Though the players from the Rapids admit this was an amazing comeback, they also admit they couldn't have done this without the kids today.
